SUBJECT: Appointment of Bryant Barksdale as Senior Director of Rules

Action Requested

The proposed resolution appoints Bryant Barksdale as the Senior Director of Rules.

Resolution

I recommend that the Executive Committee adopt the following resolution:

Resolved that Bryant Barksdale be, and hereby is appointed Senior Director of Rules effective immediately. This appointment shall continue from the date of appointment until May 31, 2015.

Background

Appointed by the Executive Committee, the Senior Director of Rules, will report to the President, be an advisor to the Executive Board and a part of the President's cabinet.

The President's Senior Director of Rules will be an advisor to the Executive Board, the Executive Committee, and the Student Assembly on matters related to the internal operations of the Student Assembly including rules.

The Senior Director of Rules will be responsible to:

- Be responsible to work with the Secretary for dissemination of information to members regarding the SUNYSA's policies and procedures.
- Ensure policy compliance, including but not limited to the attendance policy, as needed.

- Have the authority to review, develop, and recommend changes to the bylaws, policies and procedures, budget, and all governing documents of the Student Assembly.
- Have the authority to audit financial revenues and expenditures of the Student Assembly, as directed by the Executive Committee.
- Serve as an advisor to the Executive Board.

Mr. Barksdale previously served as the Senior Director of Internal Affairs of the Student Assembly and as a Representative to the Executive Committee, representing the University at Albany and Stony Brook University as a Doctoral Granting Undergraduate Representative. He has also served as the Vice President of the Student Association at the University at Albany and a graduate senator to the Albany University Senate. He is currently the Graduate Representative to the University Council.

Mr. Barksdale received his AA in General Studies from Fulton-Montgomery Community College and his BA in History from the University at Albany. He is currently working on his MS in Educational Administration and Policy Studies from the University at Albany.
