**SUBJECT: Appointment of Ashley Tyree as Senior Director of Campus Relations**

**Action Requested**

The proposed resolution appoints Ashley Tyree as Senior Director of University-Wide Success.

**Resolution**

I recommend that the Executive Committee adopt the following resolution:

Resolved that Ashley Tyree be, and hereby is appointed Senior Director of University-Wide Success; effective immediately. This appointment shall continue from the date of appointment until May 31, 2015.

**Background**

Appointed by the Executive Committee, the Senior Director of University-Wide Success will report to the President, be an advisor to the Executive Board and a part of the President's cabinet.

The President's Senior Director of University-Wide Success will be an advisor to the Executive Board, the Executive Committee, and the Student Assembly on matters related to campus relations.

The Senior Director of University-Wide Success will be responsible to:

- Be responsible for the process of establishing the system-wide policy agenda by the fall semester meeting of the Student Assembly.
- Provide, in January, a mid-year update and recommendations to the Executive Committee on the state of the policy agenda and other system-wide priorities.

- Develop a schedule of projects and goals to accomplish for the year.
- Expected to attend appropriate meetings and/or hearings, as needed.
- Serve as an advisor to the Executive Board.
- Assist the President as directed.

Ms. Tyree is a graduate student in the B.S./M.S.Ed. Childhood/Special Education program at SUNY Plattsburgh. She has been involved with SUNY Student Assembly (SUNYSA) since 2011 as a non-voting delegate, voting delegate, workshop presenter, Director of Academic Affairs (under two consecutive Presidents), and served on the Executive Board as Secretary for the 2013-2014 administration. Throughout her tenure with the organization and SUNY, she has served on various boards and committees within SUNYSA and also as the student representative to multiple SUNY wide faculty committees. She has a passion and dedication to voice student concerns to better their higher education experience and success. While at Plattsburgh, she served as a Student Association Senator for SUNY Outreach before being elected as the Executive Vice President.
