**SUBJECT: Organizational Overhaul of the Bylaws**

I recommend that the Executive Committee of the Student Assembly of the State University of New York adopt the following resolution:

Whereas, the Student Assembly of the State University of New York is the recognized voice of SUNY's almost half a million students, and;

Whereas, the organization has bylaws in place in order to have it function efficiently, and;

Whereas, over the years changes have been made to the bylaws in a reactionary manner that has hindered the organization from running efficiently. Therefore, now be it resolved;

Resolved, that the Student Assembly of the State University of New York bylaws be completely revised, and further more be it;

Resolved that a draft set of bylaws be ready to present to the General Assembly at its next convening at spring conference, and finally be it;

Resolved that the Student Assembly of the State University of New York acknowledges the validity of a complete bylaw overhaul with the adoption of this resolution.
