## **Action Requested**

The proposed resolution calls on the Student Assembly of the State University of New York (SUNY SA) students to advocate against discrimination and stereotyping to ensure the success and inclusion of students.

## Resolution

<u>WHEREAS</u>, we, the SUNY SA of the State University of New York (SUNY), acknowledge and are proud of the diversity that exists in our SUNY campuses, and;

<u>WHEREAS</u>, it is within our initiatives to ensure that students in our SUNY system are treated with respect and fairness, and;

<u>WHEREAS</u>, no student should be denied any services, entrance to any campus organizations, developmental, educational, and professional opportunities, and others, and:

<u>WHEREAS</u>, discrimination and stereotyping on the basis of gender, race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, disabilities, nationality, and others, is not acceptable and it should not be tolerated in any way, shape, or form, and;

<u>WHEREAS</u>, SUNY has enacted policies such as, but not limited to, the <u>Sexual Orientation Nondiscrimination</u>, <u>Discrimination Complaint Procedure</u>, and the <u>Equal Opportunity</u>: <u>Access, Employment and Fair Treatment in the State University of New York</u> to ensure that our students are treated respectfully, fairly, and equally across all sixty four campuses, and now therefore be it;

<u>RESOLVED</u>, that we encourage our campuses to reinforce these policies throughout the SUNY system, and be it further;
