Whereas, The SUNY Student Assembly recognizes the importance of taking precautions when approaching upcoming in climate weather in the State of New York and,

Whereas, the foreseeable conditions may cause issues with transportation for students attempting to reach and or travel to campus resources and,

Whereas, the foreseeable in climate weather conditions fail to cause immediate closures and or delays, and

Whereas, the intent of the student is to attend class to avoid any foreseeable dilemmas involving the possibility of failed attendance, class activities, participation, and or important work that may set them back in the class, and

Whereas, professors are still given the authority to dictate the validity of the circumstance on a case-by-case basis, leading to cases of ambiguity, let it stand

Resolved, that in supporting this resolution SUNY assembly recognizes and supports the idea of making the SUNY system administration review the campuses inclement weather policies on a case by case basis and

Resolved, that the SUNY Student Assembly respectfully believes that the decision of whether or not to close campuses rest on measurable metrics that call for and define what may or may not cause a campus to close.
