Action Requested

We call on the State University of New York campuses to participate in the annual “Crunch Day” with New York State apples.

Resolution

I recommend that the Student Assembly of the State University of New York (SUNYSA) adopt the following resolution:

Whereas in New York City, Crunch Day was started to celebrate New York State apples and show NYS pride; and

Whereas over the years, many SUNY campuses have started hosting their own Crunch Days; and

Whereas this past October the Sustainability Committee and the BuyNY team successfully organized some Crunch Days throughout SUNY; and

Whereas by participating in a Crunch Day, campuses are helping to Buy NY and teach students about NYS agriculture; and

Whereas students enjoyed Crunch Day and campuses indicated that they are interested in participating again; and therefore, be it

Resolved that SUNY call on their campuses to participate in a Crunch Day to celebrate NYS apples and Buy NY; and, be it further

Resolved that campuses hand out apples and seek to educate students about New York agriculture; and, finally, be it

Resolved that the Student Assembly of the State University of New York shall forward copies of this Resolution to Governor Andrew M. Cuomo, Lt. Governor Kathleen C. Hochul, the members of the New York State Legislature, the SUNY Board of Trustees, SUNY Chancellor Zimpher, University Faculty Senate, Faculty Council of Community Colleges, SUNY Campus Presidents, SUNY student governing bodies, and all other parties deemed necessary and proper.
