Action Requested

To rename the Environmental Sustainability Committee to issues of today.

Resolution

I recommend that the Executive Committee of the Student Assembly of the Student Assembly of the State University of New York (SUNYSA) adopt the following resolution:

Whereas the State University of New York was founded in 1948, and currently has a total enrollment of 465,000 students;

Whereas, the State University of New York has a student assembly established by The State University of New York Board of Trustees in 1973 with an executive cabinet consisting of specialized committees;

Whereas, one of the committees is Environmental Sustainability;

Whereas, the title of Environmental Sustainability is vague and doesn't incorporate the overarching issue of sustainability within the State University of New York system;

Let it be resolved that, the committee be renamed to the Sustainability Committee;

Let it be resolved that, the committee will not only address issues relating to the environment, but be all encompassing of facilities, energy efficiency and sustainable issues not directly relating to the environment;

Let it be resolved that, the committee will address issues of sustainability on campus within the dining facilities, residence halls, and every day campus life;
