#### Action Requested

#### Resolution

#### Background

Appointed by the Executive Committee upon the recommendation of the Community College Representatives, the Chair of Community Colleges, and/or the Vice President – the Acting Representative for Community Colleges serves as a member of the Executive Committee representing their sector until such time as an official Representative can be elected, in the case of post Fall conference, until the end of the academic year.

The Acting Representative will be responsible to:

- Make weekly contacts with respective constituency representatives as assigned by the Executive Committee.

- Serve on at least one (1) standing or ad hoc committee of the Student Assembly.
- Submit a monthly report to the Secretary at the specified due date before each Executive Committee meeting.
